Please find enclosed 1) Settlement Agreement, 2) Weisberg License, 3) Selby License.


Commensurate with your receipt of the foregoing, you are releasing papers for dismissal of Civil Action 88-3043 to the courier.

You are providing a letter to me which will allow for Dr. Wiesberg's bequest of materials to Hood college subject to the same restriction placed on Mr. Weisberg. This letter is also to allow for Mr. Weisberg's particular educational uses, lectures with free admission, research, but not any type of reproduction or retransmission or commercial exploitation. We understand that the license granted allows for the slides to contain sprocket hole material. Mr. Weisberg is of course free to contact us regarding additional royalty free licenses should the need arise.

The letter will also allow for Mr. Selby's derivation to be inherited and licensed by his estate subject to the same restrictions placed on Mr. Selby.

I will hold the dismissal papers in trust until we concur that the enclosed documents, and your letter cover our client's concerns. In this regard you acknowledge that certain language regarding Time, Inc. must be appended to the licenses.
