On page 7 of the interview with John Blozewick sent Tom Bethell by Stem Frimmer is an interesting reference to William Seymour.

Blazewick is a sailor once connected with Cuben organizations in Florida. I spoke to him on a San-Francisco radio call-in program in November, as a consequence of which he was further interviewed.

Shown a picture of Seymour by Primmer, Baazewick could not recell his name but did the face. He recalled having seen this man in Chicago at a time seemingly consistent with Seymour's first trip to floride and when he was one of a rough-lokking groups on their way to florida.

Blazewick though many of these men seemed to be drug addicts. Now when I questioned John George to see if he knew any of the group, the key that seems to have triggered his recollection was the Hell-Seymour October 1963 Dellas arrest on a dangerous-drug charge.

George recalled a pill wholeseler through whom he thinks he met them, partitudarly Hall.

If these men didrecell Seymour, it is interesting that both connect him with drugs. I wender if this could be a clas to seymour.
