At the request of the Laboratory, Bishop in my office telephonically contacted the above individual on 12/15/66 after he had attempted to contact Special Agent Lyndal L. Shaneyfelt, Bureau Laboratory, in order to arrange to interview him.

Friedman advised that he desired to conduct an interview with Shaneyfelt in order to question him concerning certain of his testimony before the Warren Commission. He stated that he desired to do this "in order to clear up some points in the testimony of Shaneyfelt."

Friedman was advised by Bishop that all of Shaneyfelt's investigations and examinations made in connection with the FBI's investigation into the assassination had been completely reported to the Warren Commission and that no purpose would be served by his interviewing Shaneyfelt.

Friedman stated that he understood.
