Commission, the Laboratory has reviewed the cameras recovered that are reported to be Loc Barvey Oswald's, as well as an Angeo flash attachment and an empty leather case. Representatives of the Commission asked whether or not the empty leather case could be used on either of the cameras and whether or not the Ansco flash attachment could fit either camera.

These items were reviewed and the empty
leather case was found to be a case for a small pair
of binoculars and could not have been used for either
of Oswald's cameras. It is noted that both of the
cameras are presently in cases. The flash attachment
was found to contain a camera connection that is
different from that used on Oswald's cameras and,
therefore, it could not be used without some intermediate
adapter. A llinex camera, which has just been received
from Dallan and is reported to be the property of
urs. Ruth Paine's husband, wen also checked and found
tq/have no flash connector for use with a flash adapter.
