Clay Shaw Is Hospitalized

NEW ORLEANS, March 18 (UPI) — Clay L. Shaw, one of the men District Attorney Jim Garrison has accused of conspiring to kill President John F. Kennedy, was admitted to Southern Baptist Hospital Saturday for what a hospital spokesman termed "rest and medical treatment."

Shaw's attorneys, said Shaw had indicated his back was bothering him during the preliminary hearing.

Earlier today, one of Garrison's top aides said it would be at least several months before Shaw is brought to trial for the alleged conspiracy against Kennedy.
