**Shaw Defense  
Asks Subpena  
Of 2 More**

Attorneys for Clay L. Shaw today asked that two more witnesses be subpoenaed for Monday's pre-trial hearing. The two are William Gurvich, a former investigator for District Attorney Jim Garrison, and Roy Jacob, reportedly also a private investigator. Shaw faces trial on charges of criminal conspiracy in the slaying of President John F. Kennedy. Gurvich, of 5401 Cleveland pl., was publicly described as Garrison's chief investigator in the Kennedy death probe before he quit June 22, claiming the probe is a hoax. No explanation was given for the calling of Jacob. His address was listed as 417 16th st.
