

Court Expands Police Power: Cop Can Order Traffic

The Supreme Court today gave police broader power to control the actions of persons they stop for routine violations of the law.

THE COURT ALSO announced these other decisions today:

- It agreed to decide whether a lower federal court may go ahead and decide a case in which the late Clay L. Shaw of New Orleans claimed his civil rights were violated when he

was unsuccessfully prosecuted on the theory that he was involved in the assassination of President John F. Kennedy in 1963.
