Trial of a \$7 million damage suit brought by Clay L. Shaw against Dist. Atty. Jim Garri-son and others has been set for June 18 by U.S. District Court Judge Frederick J. R. Hente

His suit names as co-defend-ants Joseph M. Rault Jr., Ce-cil M. Shilstone and Willard Robertson, members of "Truth and Consequences."
