- Mayor Kevin H. White warned Boston citizens that they face a tax increase, labor and racial troubles this year. As he addressed the City Council, 200 uniformed firemen paraded outside to protest a breakdown in wage negotiations with the city.

- Lawyers for Clay Shaw, accused of conspiring to assassinate President Kennedy, filed a motion to have his trial moved out of New Orleans. The trial is scheduled to start Jan. 21.

- The New York City Board of Health lifted the "state of great peril" that had been declared last month because of the cold weather, the fuel drivers' strike and the flu epidemic.
