U.S. District Judge Frank G. Theis, 86, who presided over the case involving nuclear plant whistleblower Karen Silkwood during his more than 30 years on the federal bench, died Saturday in Wichita after suffering a stroke.

F. Irvin Dymond, 83, the New Orleans lawyer who won an acquittal for businessman Clay Shaw in the John F. Kennedy assassination conspiracy trial later fictionalized by moviemaker Oliver Stone, died of cancer Saturday.

Marilyn Costello, 72, principal harpist for the Philadelphia Orchestra, died of cancer Jan. 5. In 1974 she won the orchestra's C. Hartman Kuhn Award given to its leading musician. Newsday 1/20/98
