

CLAY L. SHAW Files motion

CLAY L. SHAW has filed a motion in New Orleans Criminal District Court, arguing that Dist. Atty. JIM GARRISON failed to prove he conspired in the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY so perjury charges stemming from the trial are not valid.

Garrison, who has been ill with a back ailment, took the stand briefly. He testified about his opening statement in the trial last year in which Shaw was accused of conspiring to kill Kennedy. Shaw was acquitted of that charge, but subsequently was charged with perjury for testifying in the trial that he never knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD or DAVID W. FERRIE.
