

Name Clay Shaw Renovation Chief

NEW ORLEANS (AP) — Clay Shaw, once charged by New Orleans Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison with complicity in the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, has been appointed to manage the renovation of the city's French Market.

Shaw, appointed yesterday, was named to the French Market Board six months ago after a federal judge ordered Garrison to cease actions against Shaw in connection with the Kennedy slaying in Dallas.

Shaw was acquitted of conspiracy charges in the assassination, then was charged with lying during his trial. The latter charges were dismissed and the federal judge barred further prosecution.

The historic market is to be renovated at a cost of \$2.5 million.
