It has been to zero here and I haven't been able to winterize the house. I'll also have to take the diving board down and in. I can't go away and leave the place like this. But I'll get them done promptly.

Paul will send me a copy of his wasp memo, so if I have anything to add, I'll do it promptly. I forgot to ask him if he has the report that says IHO's fingerprints were not on the leaflet (without saying whose were), but I have you a copy of that last week.

This will not get to go out until tomorrow night, so do not read intruston into a simple delay. If you are not in the office Saturday, you will not get it until Monday. I will not be able to leave to go to town tomorrow until after the morning mail has gone. Therefore, it will not leave until the night mail.
