This is all it says. The time is that in Dallas. This will now have to be checked, and somehow I'll do it. It is arranged through a Dr. Klyper.

There is a possibility similar footage is at Metromedia. I have asked Dick to check with WNEW-TV in New York, which taped everything they sired and once offered me access to it. Of this I have not heard from him.

I have also checked with MAI-TV New Director Baker. He does not know what footage they may have retained formthat is under a different department. However, he will check to see if this is included. I have also saked him for an inventory, if they have retained any.

He also knows Tarsikes, though not intimately, and "admires his work". Tarsikes was with the Express-News.

There are inventories of the Dallas-stations' footage. I me de notes on them at the Archives. Then Tom returns, why not ask him if he exemined these files, for it he did he should have noted the New Orleans entries. The numbers he can find from Whitewesh II.
