

HENRY FORD CHOOSE

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ROBERT E. SHERWOOD says:

It is easy to understand why Hitler and Goebbels were once so confident that the conquest of the United States of America would be "an inside job."

They were assuming that Henry Ford is the United States of America; and they knew that they had already successfully invaded and occupied Henry Ford.

Of course, Hitler and Goebbels could view America only from their own Nazi (or pig's eye) point of view. What they have seen is not a nation of living individuals (they can not admit that individuals exist); they have seen a symbol — a figure in a cartoon.

That symbol bears a startling resemblance to Henry Ford. It is a conception of a man who has accomplished much in former times but is now well past his prime. He is probably the world's greatest genius in industrial mass production — and the methods he originated and developed are an essential factor in the New World Order; but, combined with his mechanical genius, is an emotional ingenuousness, an intellectual sterility, a rustic narrow-mindedness — a general goofiness — which make him a supreme easy mark for the international gangsters.

The creator of the Model T and the Lincoln Zephyr is the same man who once was talked into believing he could stop a World War by sending a Peace Ship to Europe . . . who dismissed the whole experience of man with the statement that history is bunk . . . who contributed the authority of his name and the vast power of his money to the perpetration of a fraud against an entire race and who, long after the fraud had been exposed and admitted, continued the world-wide perpetration on the naive assumption that even if The Protocols were not true they ought to be.

When the Nazis pinned a decoration on Henry Ford they were honoring their own symbol of the United States of America, and happily expressing their confidence in their own future.

Now they are learning that their conception of us (like Ribbentrop's conception of the British) was somewhat inaccurate.

Let us hope that Henry Ford may have the good will and good sense to confess that he, too, has learned how gravely he has misrepresented our free country.

Let us hope that many Americans, who do not forget the enormous contributions that Henry Ford has made to our industrial progress, will join with the Friends of Democracy in this appeal to his patriotism and his better judgment.

HENRY FORD MUST CHOOSE

The name, the influence and the publications of the outstanding industrial leader of America, Henry Ford, have been used and are being used today by Adolf Hitler's henchmen for Nazi propaganda purposes.

Hitler's chief propaganda weapon now, as always, is anti-Semitism. He has used it to set race against race, to divide nations internally, to foment hatred and disunity, and thus to prepare the way for Nazi conquest.

Whether Henry Ford wants his name and his publications to be used for this purpose, whether he is aware of the extent to which Hitler has thus used him, is beside the point. The fact remains that his name, more than that of any other American, is being so used by the Nazis.

This situation has come about because in 1920 Mr. Ford ordered and financed America's first all-out attack upon people of the Jewish faith. For seven years his newspaper, The Dearborn Independent, published articles designed to set Christian against Jew. Collections of these articles were published by Mr. Ford in a book called The International Jew and scattered the length and breadth of the land.

Mr. Ford's attack upon Jews was based upon The Protocols of the Elders of Zion, a thin volume which purports to relate a plan whereby "international Jewry" seeks to conquer and enslave the world. Although this book has been declared a forgery by all competent scholars and by courts of law, Mr. Ford gave it his endorsement. All English editions of the book reprint that endorsement in the introduction.

By conducting an attack upon Jews and by endorsing *The Protocols* Mr. Ford grievously harmed all the free peoples of the world, for the brand of anti-Semitism he helped to popularize has become the basis of all Nazi propaganda and a major weapon of power politics. In his rise to power Adolf Hitler simply repeated the anti-Semitic libels which had appeared in *The Protocols* and in Mr. Ford's publications.

Obviously Adolf Hitler believed himself to be indebted to Mr. Ford. For years a picture of Mr. Ford hung behind his desk at the Brown House.

When Mr. Ford campaigned for the Presidential nomination, Hitler said, "I wish that I could send some of my shock troops to Chicago and other big American cities to help in the elections."

Hitler's book, Mein Kampf, refers favorably to only one American - Henry Ford.

The official program of the Nazi party refers favorably to only one American — Henry Ford.

The first American to be honored by the Nazis with the Grand Cross of the German Eagle was Henry Ford.

In 1927 Mr. Ford apologized to all men of good will for the wrong he had done. He said he had not known his publications were conducting an anti-Semitic campaign. He said he had learned *The Protocols* to be forgeries. His closest associates said he ordered the campaign and approved its every detail. But he that as it may, he apologized and promised to undo the harm he had caused.

Mr. Ford has not done so. His book. The International Jew, has been translated into a dozen languages, and at this very moment it is being used by Hitler's agents to divide and confuse the peoples he would conquer. At this very moment it is being distributed in the United States by the apostles of Nazism.

Mr. Ford declared *The Protocols* to be a forgery, but he has taken no action to enjoin its publishers from reprinting the endorsement he once volunteered. Nazi publishers continue to use the prestige of the name of Henry Ford to help sell this book which is one of the foundation stones of Nazism.

When Mr. Ford apologized in 1927 he shifted the responsibility for the anti-Semitic campaign to his editor, W. J. Cameron. Mr. Cameron immediately formed an organization which continued the campaign. Even today that organization is distributing *The Protocols* and other standard pieces of Nazi propaganda. Yet Mr. Cameron remains in the employ of Henry Ford. He is the voice of Henry Ford.

These are critical times. The fate of democracy, the history of the next thousand years hang in the balance. The issue is not anti-Semitism. A way of life is involved. Shall we have democracy which is bared upon equality and cooperation, or shall we have Nazism which is based upon slavery and repression?

The time has come when all men must stand up and be counted. Either they are for our way of life or they are against it.

Henry Ford must speak. But he must do more than speak. He must act. He must take action in the courts to insure that his name no longer be used by the Nazi movement both here and abroad. If he refuses to do so, he stands self-condemned.

NAZIS USE FORD'S BOOK



Ninety-one of the most vicious anti-Semitic articles from The Dearborn Independent were reprinted in three volumes by the Dearborn Publishing Company, another Ford property. These books, which are reproduced below, were shipped out of the Ford offices by the carload. Each issue of The Dearborn Independent advertised them prominently. Later they appeared under two titles only - The International Jew and The Jewish Question. These books have been translated into many languages and sold all over the world—in Germany, France, Spain, Portugal, Japan, Rumania, Sweden, England, the South American Republics. They are being sold today, both in this country and abroad. Wherever Hitler's advance guard is found spreading its disruptive propaganda, there the books will be found, usually with Ford's name prominently displayed on the cover. 

THE FORGED PROTOCOLS



FNDORSED BY FORD



In twenty-two short words Ford made a tremendous contribution to Nazism. During the last twenty years, wherever The Protocols have been published in the English language, Ford's endorsement appears on the first page of the book, set apart in bold-face type as shown above. By using his endorsement the publishers endow The Protocols with the power and prestige of the name of Ford.

Ford first made the above statement in an authorized interview with his old friend, J. J. O'Neill. Six years later he publicly admitted that he had been dearned The Protocols were "gross forgeries." But his original statement gave the impetus which sold, and is still selling, millions of copies of this document which is the basis of Nazi propaganda.

THE PROTOCOLS AGREE

Their words differ slightly, but Ford's International Jew, Hitler's Mein Kampf and The Protocols tell the same story. All three accuse the Jews of seeking to dominate the world. The surprise in this package is that Hitler actually uses the same plan he attributes to Jews. By means of that plan he is working to dominate the world, while trying to direct the fear and hatred of the world against the Jews.

Henry Ford:

"Jewish conspirators planned the world war."

Adolf Hitler:

"Thanks to his international influence, he (the Jew) ensnares with a net of enemies those peoples which put up a too violent resistance against the enemy from within, and he drives them into war..."

The Protocols:

"We must be in a position to respond to every act of opposition by war with the neighbors of that country which dares to oppose us..."

Henry Ford:

"There has been established a secret empire, an invisible super-government of the Jews."

Adolf Hitler:



THE NAZIS SPEND AMERICAN DOLLARS




There is no doubt that the Nazi movement during its early days was partially financed with American money. Competent authorities have testified that Henry Ford conributed generously. After Hitler's November putsch in Munich, Herr Auer, vice-president of the Bavarian Diet testified before Ebert, president of Germany, that "the Hitler movement was partly financed by an American anti-Semitic leader, who is Henry Ford." He testified further that "Herr Hitler openly boasts of Mr. Ford's support and praises Mr. Ford, not as a great individualist but as a great anti-Semite." Konrad Heiden, who is generally conceded to be the greatest authority on the early days of the Nazi movement, wrote: "That Henry Ford gave money to the National Socialists . . . bas never been disputed."

Hitler has shown his admiration for Ford in a number of ways. Each of the news stories reproduced above notes that

Ford's photograph occupies "the place of honor" in Hitler's office in the Brown House. Each notes that the tables outside the office are piled high with the German translation of a book bearing the name of Henry Ford on its cover. Raymond Fendrick reported (see above) Hitler as saying: "We have just had his anti-Jewish articles translated and published. The book is being circulated to millions throughout Germany." The book to which Hitler refers is The International Jew. Thus, it appears that Hitler owes Ford more than mere financial support. Ford's The International Jew made invaluable propagands for Hitler's growing movement.

When Ford campaigned for the presidential nomination in the United States, Hitler publicly expressed his gratitude. "I wish," he said, "that I could send my shock troops to Chicago and other big American cities to help in the elections. We look upon Heinrich Ford as the leader of the growing Fascisti movement."

Every loyal American citizen in Michigan should read the last two numbers of Mr. George Harvey's WAR WERKLY. In these numbers there are quotations from Mr. Henry Ford's speeches made two years ago and again since we entered the war. Mr. Ford has not questioned the accuracy of these quotations given by Mr. Harvey. Speaking of American flags over his own factory Mr. Ford said: "I don't believe in the flag. When the war is over these flags shall come down, never to go up again."

The sedition act, approved by President Wilson, inflicts a maximum punishment of twenty years in the penitentiary for any man who while we are at war utters "Language intended to bring the flag of the United States into contempt or disrepute."

During the last year many poor and ignorant men have been convicted and sentenced for using language thus forbidden by law. In my view the fact that Mr. Ford is an enormously wealthy man ought not to give him immunity from the law, if he cannot show that he did not use the language quoted in the Was WEEKLY. But whether or not amenable to the law, no patriotic American can afford to put in the Senate, perhaps to help negotiate the peace treaty, a man who announces that as soon as peace comes he wishes to haul down the American flag and never again to hoist it. To send such a man to the Senate professing such sentiments under existing conditions would give the enemy a wholly wrong idea of the pacific sentiment of our country.

There is nothing in the world which would now help Germany as much or, give her, so much heart in her struggle for the overthrow of liberty and democracy as the belief that men professing such sentiments would have part in the peace negotiations on behalf of this country.

Among the further utterances of Mr. Ford (as given in the WAR WEEKLY) is one that "he does not believe in patricism" and that "he does not care any more for the United States than China or Hindoostan."

This particular manifestion was too absurd even to do harm, but so far as it had an effect at all it encouraged Germans to believe that we were as neutral between right and wrong as Pontius, and that as far as we were concerned she could safely proceed with wrongdoing because we held the scales of judgment even between the wrongdore and his victim. The crusade also included an extraordinary series of advertisements issued long after the Lustionia was sunk, in which Mr. Ford violently opposed and denounced preparedness, advocated and approved the McLemore resolution, and announced that it was our duty to keep out of war and not merely himself kept silent about the wrongdoing on the ground that they "Had bred racial hatred by the printing of incendiary news stories and articles." It may well be doubted whether this propaganda did not do more damage to the American people than the propaganda caried on



Ford apologized to the Jews on July 14, 1927. He admitted that The Dearborn Independent and The International Jew were his property, but he pleaded that "in the multitude of my activities . . . it has been impossible for me . . . to keep informed as to their contents." He continued: "Had I appreciated even the general nature, to say nothing of the details of these utterances, I would have forbidden their circulation without a moment's hesitation."



Yet only six years earlier Henry Ford authorized a statement issued by his secretary, E. G. Liebold, saying that "The Dearborn Independent is Henry Ford's own paper and he authorizes every statement occuring therein." That statement was released to the press June 10, 1921, almost two years after the campaign was launched against the Jews in "Henry Ford's own paper" and a year after the publication of The International Jew which was advertised weekly in The Dearborn Independent. "Mr. Ford's page" appeared in each issue, often in a spot close to the anti-Semitic article of the week, and yet he disclaimed knowledge of the campaign. Is it possible? 





An editorial in Destiny explained: "We are publishing this without comment, but with the hope that all the truth will ultimately be given to our peo-ple." Significantly, a dozen or more Nazi organizations in the United States reprinted Gen-eral Moseley's statement and distributed it throughout the mation. anti-Semitic and pro-Nazi propa-ganda distributed by the Anglo-Saxon Federation. They deal in many of the standard Nazi propaganda pieces. The Program of Con-fusion and The Jewish Question, reprounced above, are distributed by many avowedly fascistic organizations. The pamphlet, Was Jesus a Jew? was written by Mr. cameron and published by the Anglo-Saxon Federation. According to Mr. Cameron, Jesus was not a Jew.

In May of 1939 General George Van Horn Moseley was hailed before the Dies Committee. Testimony revealed a plot on the part of several of the nation's ranking Nazi leaders to overthrow representative government in the United States and to establish General Moseley as a dictator. The plot was nipped in the bud, and the retired officer was thoroughly discredited among all men and women who believe in democracy.

But the Anglo-Saxon Federation, through its magazine, Destiny, rushed to the defense of General Moseley. The July issue of the magazine contained a supplement re-printing Moseley's prepared state-ment which the Dies Committee had refused to hear, because it consisted of nothing but rabid anti-Semitism.

Robert Edward Edmondson is the most prolific Nazi propagandist in the United States. S. A. Ackley is in charge of the Chicago branch of the Anglo-Saxon Federation. The letter from Ackley to Edmondson, reproduced above, was first published in The National American, a Nazi propaganda newspaper which for some years decorated its masthead with a swastika.

Ackley's statement to Edmondson that "I am in entire sympathy with what you are trying to do" is especially significant, for it is a well known fact that Edmondson is working to establish a government patterned after Nazism. When General George Van Horn Moseley was exposed by the Dies Committee as a conspirator against the government, Edmondson rushed to his defense. In a printed leaflet, headed "Hail Moseley," he wrote: "And because - be it not overlooked - in this world war of national patriotism against internationalization, soldier-patriot leaders like yourself saved Germany, Italy, Japan, Spain, from annihilation."

Thus to Edmondson, an apostle of Nazism and a defender of conspirators, Ackley wrote: "Furthermore, Mr. W. J. Cameron, our national president, was for many years the editor of The Dearborn Independent and if anyone knows who the Jews are and what their motives and purposes are, Mr. Cameron does. Do you suppose for a minute that he could be persuaded to head up a movement such as the Anglo-Saxon Federation is . . . if, as your circular suggests, we are pro-Jewish?"

I have been looking over your program ---your world program ---again, and it still looks good to me, but it will take five years to fill it in, and that is just about the length of time Mr. F. has told us it will take to accomplish anything. Beginning with conditions here, using certain parallel conditions abroad for illustration, and then widening the investigation to include the other American Republics, and so on, is probably themethod that would meet most approval here.

The four principal matters which are engaging me now are the Press, Financial, Industrial and Political angles---and no doubt you will pick up by the way many a brick that I can build into one of these four walls.

I was very much disappointed that the American Hebrew did not continue, its campaign against the Protocols. It promised something big. There were only two astonishingly mediocre articles, and then a third which consisted in a comic Protocol, and now apparently the campaign is off. I have several big shells in reserve on this matter, but I have been waiting for a suitable target.

The case of Dr. H. is giving me some concern. I feel that we need him, but he has injured the confidence in which one other here held him, and he did it principally by keeping us all steadily informed how hard up he was. The fact that he promised information which never materialized hasn't helped him. He has an arrangement which runs through October and I feel that if it is to be continued, he must shake himself into shape somehow. I am telling you this, thinking that you perhaps might know of some way to do this. If he could give us that I.W.W. history and the narcotic stuff now, it might help. Or if he could substantiate some of the rumors and tips he has handed us. I don't know how well you know him, or anything about that, but he is a man I would like to help along if possible, both for himself and the service he may be able to give us.

C. C. Daniels, to whom Cameron addresses this letter, was the head of Ford's New York secret service. The significant paragraph is the one in which Cameron refers to "your world program" - which "will take five years to fill in, and that is just about the. length of time Mr. F. has told us it. would take to accomplish anything." Since this was written four months after the virulent anti-Semitic cam-, paign had started in The Dearborn' Independent and since Ford was already laying his lines for the Presidency, it is safe to say that these two factors were to form the cornerstones of the prospective "world program."

Hitler, too, was formulating a world program at the same time, and Cameron's letter mentions "using certain parallel conditions abroad for illustration" to the peoples of the Americas. It is evident that the "parallel conditions abroad" in which Ford was emotionally interested were those occurring in Germany. For there the Nazi Party was promulgating a program which included the liquidation of Jewish life. and also of the international bankers and industrialist in favor of the "creative" industrialists like Henry Ford who was hailed as "the ideal type." These outstanding elements of the original Nazi program agreed with Ford's own passionate convictions; and Cameron's, as well, it appears.

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

HENRY FORD MUST CHOOSE

Henry Ford must know that he is being used by Fascist groups all over the world.

Therefore, we call upon Henry Ford, as a loyal and liberty-loving American, to do the following:

 Stop the further publication and circulation of pamphlets and books containing copies of or extracts from The Dearborn Independent articles.

The following organizations and publishers, among others, are known to be disseminating and circulating such material in the United States: Robert Edward Edmondson, Stoddarts-ville, Pennsylvania; the American Nationalist Confederation, St. Albans, West Virginia; the Aryan Book Store, Los Angeles, California; William Kullgren, Atascadero, California; the Christian Free Press, Glendale, California; La Prensa, New York City. Foreign editions are being published and distributed by the following: Luz, Buenos Aires, Argentina; Livraria do Globo, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; Casa Editrice Sonzogno, Milan, Italy; Hammer Verlag, Leipzig, Germany; Svea Rikes Forlag, Stockholm, Sweden; Editions R.I.S.S., Paris, France; Britons Publishing Society, London, England.

Mr. Ford should demand publicly that these organizations and publishers cease to use The Dearborn Independent articles in any manner, shape or form. He should address the same demand to each organization and publisher individually. If the demand is not observed forthwith, Mr. Ford should institute appropriate legal proceedings.

2. Stop the further publication and circulation of pamphlets and books quoting Mr. Ford's endorsement of The Protocols of The Elders of Zion or quoting other anti-Semitic statements of Mr. Ford which presumably no longer represent Mr. Ford's true beliefs.

Sanctuary, New York City; the Christian Free Press, Glendale, California; Mrs. L. Fry, Los Angeles, California; Nationalist Press, New York City; Mrs. Livingston Schuyler, New York City; Pete Stahrenberg, New York City: Robert Edward Edmondson, Stoddartsville, Pennsylvania; Charles B. Hudson, Omaha, Nebraska; Elizabeth Dilling, Chicago, Illinois.

Mr. Ford should announce publicly that he no longer endorses The Protocols, which are proved forgeries, and that he repudiates the other libels on Jews which he promulgated years ago. He should address like repudiations to organizations and publishers individually. After this is done, Mr. Ford will be in a position to compel by legal proceedings a stoppage of the further dissemination of all written material falsifying his true beliefs. And he should institute legal proceedings against any and all organizations and publishers who continue to falsify.

3. Mr. Ford must make periodic statements to the press, giving the fullest publicity to the action that he is taking.

Because the Nazis have exploited the name and publications of Mr. Ford, millions of people in the world believe he is sympathetic to Hitlerism. To counteract this impression, Mr. Ford must fully inform the public of his acts in repudiating anti-Semitism and Nazism, thus clearly assuring by widespread publicity that his name can never again be used to sell Hitler's doctrines to the American people.

4. Proceed immediately to dissociate himself absolutely from W. J. Cameron.

In 1927 Mr. Ford sought to shift to Cameron the blame for The Dearborn Independent libels. He promised that he would dissociate himself from Cameron. We nevertheless find that Cameron is still the voice of Ford on the radio and at the same time pursues the most flagrant anti-Semitic activities. Mr. Ford must be enough of a realist to know that so long as he employs Cameron to speak for him over the air, he is necessarily associated in the public mind with all anti-Semitic activities conducted by Cameron. Mr. Ford cannot prove his good faith except by dismissing Cameron at once and announcing publicy that he repudiates any and all anti-Semitic declarations made by Cameron.

5. After Mr. Ford has taken the steps outlined above, let him prosecute for libel any one who states he is anti-Semitic.

At the present moment Mr. Ford is in no position to take such a step, since the record shows that he has acquiesced in widespread anti-Semitic activities in which his name and prestige have been employed by the foulest defamers of the Jewish race.

If Mr. Ford does not see fit to take any of the steps which we have here called upon him to take, we submit he will stand convicted as an enemy of the American people.
