C., made available to SA an army photograph taken on October 22, 1967, at the Pentagon following the anti-Vietnam demonstration. The photograph shows various writings on the wall of the Pentagon, one of which is, "Who is John Galt?" he did not see the actual writing and his knowledge is limited to his noticing the writing on the photograph. He did not know the significance of the writing, if any, but wanted to bring it to the attention of the FBI because of the name "Galt."
