On November 22, 1963, WILLIAM ALLEN SIMMS, III, 813 North Rampart Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, temporary address, YMCA, Beaumont, Texas, advised that three or four months ago a man he now identifies as LEE HARVEY OSWALD was observed on Canal Street at New Orleans near a Walgreen's Drug Store passing out pamphlets which took the position that the United States Covernment was entirely wrong in its dealings with Cuba and in the Korean matter, and defended the present Cuban Government. SIMMS advised he called the New Orleans Police Department and was told that several complaints had previously been received. SIMMS had no further information concerning the man's identity, organization connections, associates or other activities.
