

Sinarquist Ban PM Is Extended

Allied Labor News reports from Mexico City that President Manuel Avila Camacho has extended the ban on meetings of the fascist National Sinarquist Union to all of Mexico. The original ban, imposed June 22, affected only the eight states where Sinarquist activity was centered.

The weekly news magazine *Tempo* reported that the Sinarquist organization is going underground and is urging all its members to obtain arms.

Allied Labor News quoted U. S. Ambassador George Messersmith as, heatedly denying charges by former Sinarquist chieftain Salvador Abascal that the U. S. Embassy "managed the Sinarquists too much." Messersmith called the charges absurd and said:

"The U. S. Embassy does not intervene in Mexican politics. The Sinarquists are considered fascists and we will not help those we are fighting against."
