

Nab Sirhan brother in Golda threat

LOS ANGELES (AP) — A brother of the convicted assassin of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy has been indicted by a federal grand jury on a charge of making a threat against the life of Israeli Premier Golda Meir.

Sharif Bassam Sirhan, 39, was held Monday on \$30,000 bond after his indictment. He was arrested by the FBI at his residence in nearby Pasadena without incident.

The FBI said the threat was contained in a letter addressed to Sec. of State William P. Rogers about one month ago. Mrs. Meir recently completed a visit to the United States. Details of the threat were not revealed.

Sharif is an older brother of Sirhan B. Sirhan, now serving a life term in San Quentin Prison for the 1968 slaying of Kennedy.
