SIRHAN SIRHAN (left), convicted of assassinating Senator Robert Kennedy in 1968, appealed his conviction to the U.S. Supreme Court yesterday. He cited "newly discovered physical evidence" but did not say what it was. Kennedy was shot in a Los Angeles hotel as he was leaving a celebration of his victory in the California Democratic presidential primary. A man identified as Sirhan fired a pistol several times before he was wrestled to the ground by bystanders.
