## Polka Dot Girl Dies of Drug Dose

LOS ANGELES—A young woman first identified as the mysterious girl in a polka dot dress sought in the Robert F. Kennedy assassination has died of a drug overdose, police said today,

Kathy Fullmer, 23, who worked as a go-go dancer under the name of Sundy Rossi, checked into a motel in suburban El Sereno Monday at 7:30 A.M., and left a call for 5:30 P.M.

When the motel management got no response to the 5:30 call, it opened the door and found Miss Fullmer in a coma, apparently from an overdose of seconal.

On the mirror she had scrawled:

"Lord you gave me a moun-in tain iain I am love to elimb

Miss Fullmer surrendered to police last June saying she believed she was the injusticious woman in a police det des seen at the Ambassher Hotel the night Kenneds was show Police felt at the that she had turned herself in to get publicity.

A police search turned in a number of women who said they were wearing polks dot dresses at the party celebratering the New York Senstor's victory in the California pressidential primary. She said she was wearing a green dress with yellow polkadots and did not know Sirhan.
