

**Psychiatrist in Sirhan Case
Won't Be Sued on Testimony**

The Bernard Geis Associates publishing company said Saturday that it would not sue a psychiatrist whose report on the mental condition of Sirhan B. Sirhan was allegedly similar to language used in a book published by the company.

The findings of the psychiatrist, Dr. Martin M. Schorr of San Diego, have been used at the trial of Sirhan, assassin of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. Dr. Schorr reportedly used language similar to that in Dr. James A. Brussel's "A Casebook of a Crime Psychiatrist," published by Bernard Geis Associates.

In announcing that his company would not sue, Mr. Geis said, "I feel that prosecution would be persecution."
