In Chicago legal researcher Sherman Skolnick and his chauffeur have been reported missing. The two failed to return from a meeting Skolnick had told his associates was connected with the Watergate case. Skolnick was carrying a file on Watergate when he disappeared. Earlier this month Skolnick had filed a \$2 million damage suit charging that his rights were violated when he was refused permission to testify before the National Transportation Safety Board. The Board at that time was investigating a plane crash that killed Mrs. E. Howard Hunt, wife of one of the figures in the Watergate affair. Skolnick claimed he had evidence that would link the crash to the Watergate investigation.....
