The suit, filed by legal researcher Sherman Skolnick, contends the archives are withholding information that shows Kennedy died not at the hands of a lone assassin but as the result of assassin but as the result of

The suit asserts that five conspirators planned to kill Kennedy at the Army-Air Force football game in Chicago Nov. 2, 1963. But when the President canceled his appearance because of a cold at the last minute, the suit continued, the assassination attempt was rescheduled for Dallas three weeks later. later. V
