Guerra, 29, was picked up by the narcotics squad on the West Side as he allegedly sold drugs to a person in a taxicab. Police said he was holding two \$50 bags and 14 \$5 bags of marijuana.

Guerra's flight on Oct. 5, 1969, stirred a controversy when it was disclosed that his Russian-built plane had flown within 65 miles of the Floria coast before it was picked up by radar. He was a Cuban ir force lieutenant at the time.
