2 Jailed for 25 Years as Dope Smugglers

NEW YORK, June 19—Two French members of an international narcotics smuggling ring said to have brought \$293 million worth of heroin here from France were jailed for 25 years each today.

Manhattan Federal Court Judge Edward Weinfeld imposed the sentences upon Charles Laurent Fioconni, 31, of Paris and Jean Claude

Kella of Toulon, who were convicted last month after a nine-day trial.

A codefendant, Louis Cirillo, 48, was jailed for 25 years last month. From his backyard federal agents recovered more than \$1 million in cash which was said to be the proceeds of the heroin operation.

Both Frenchmen still face heroin-importing charges on

a Boston, Mass., indictment.

The government showed that the ring succeeded in bringing heroin into the United States by secreting large quantities in expensive automobiles shipped on luxury liners.
