French Skipper Sentenced In Big Seizure of Heroin

MARSEILLES, France, Jan. 5-(AP) - A Marseilles court gave a 15-year prison sentence today to Louis Boucan, a captain of a fishing boat on which 900 pounds of heroin was found. The seizure was reported at the time to be the biggest in his

time to be the biggest in history.

Boucan was arrested last of Feb. 28 when customs ment boarded his boat off Ville of franche-sur-Mer on the Medicaterranean as it was starting out on a trip to Miami. The heroin was found in concrete covers on the boat's holds.

Boucan, who is 58 years old a testified at his trial that he had made two previous trips to see

had made two previous trips ton the United States in fishing: boats.

Ange Santoni, 41, also was sentenced to 15 years in prison a The authorities said he was to take charge of the heroin, in Migni Meric Francisco Miami. Marie-Françoise de Pas-i mari. Marie-françoise de Passis sario-Peyssard, Boucan's for-in mer wife, was sentenced to two years in prison.

Four other men tried in above sentia were given sentences a ranging from 2 to 20 years.
