And so to Allen Zoll, mentioned letter to Bundman in Smythe's Wheeler-Hill,

We're interested in Zoll because the picketing of WMCA was preceded by a mass meeting at the Manhattan Opera House. This meeting was sponsored by the American Committee for Defense of Constitutional Rights and convened to 1) agitate for the return of Father Coughlin's talks to WMCA; 2) protest against the removal (from the air) of Father Coughlin, Congress-man Dies and Boake Carter°; 3) protest against radio monopoly.

One of the organizations participating in this mass meeting was the American Patriots, Inc. Allen Zoll is headman of this outfit.

Not only is Zoll on record as being pro-Nazi (Dickstein files) but we

have Smythe's letter as printed in the German American Bund's Deutscher Heckruf und Beobachter, and reproduced on page 35, to prove that Zoll requested and received Bund aid and

cooperation. Obviously Zoll and his American Patriots, Inc., are pro-Nazi. We think this proves that the picket lines outside WMCA are Nazi inspired, Nazi led, Nazi staffed.

Now we don't claim that Father Coughlin's a Nazi even the his more recent utterances sound that way. Nor do we claim Father Coughlin is responsible for a Nazi picket line outside WMCA. After all it is a long way from Detroit to Manhattan and quite possible that he doesn't know who these supporters are and never who these supporters are and never solicited their aid.

But we'd like to hear Father Coughlin denounce these supporters,

reveal them as the anti-American, anti-Democratic, anti-religious groups that they are.

And in the interests of free speech

we wish Father Coughlin'd agree to (Continued on page 37)
