INQUIRY HAS DISCLOSED THAT AN INDIVIDUAL USING NAME OF RAMON GEORGE SNEYD TRAVELED ON BOAC FROM TORONTO TO LONDON ON MAY SIX, SIXTY-EIGHT. PERSON USING THE SAME NAME RETURNED TO TORONTO ON BOAC MAY TWENTY-ONE, SIXTY-EIGHT.

YOU SHOULD ACCOUNT FOR WHEREABOUTS OF SNEYD DURING PERIOD MAY SIX TO TWENTY-ONE. CHECK SHOULD BE MADE TO DETERMINE IF SNEYD DEPARTED LONDON DURING THAT PERIOD BY FLIGHTS TO OTHER COUNTRIES, PARTICULARLY SWITZERLAND. ALSO CHECK TO DETERMINE IF BANKING ACCOUNT OR SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX OPENED BY SNEYD IN LONDON DURING THIS PERIOD.

CHECK BOAC PERSONNEL TO DETERMINE IF PERSON RETURNING TO TORONTO ON MAY TWENTY-ONE WAS IDENTICAL WITH PERSON ARRIVING LONDON ON MAY SIX USING NAME SNEYD.
