Then, with four minutes on the event, the entire newscast, back to another bible thumper. Their news was no different than what had been aired...My hunch is that it is a more violent black protest, conditions having gotten to the point where those involved feel death is worth the effectiveness of the lesson they hope to teach. The only alternative of which I can think is that all are insane. Makes me regret nothing happened with Desiree. Too early for the paper and WFL has music-religious. Other stations add little to last night's accounts. It seems apparent that the men are skilled in the use of their weapons and have abundant ammo, no special trick with a motel, where the carrying of a bag attracts no attention. Even if across the street from Rault's Bldg, which I think is the case, and only 10 blocks from the jail and central police headquarters. RM
