I had a copy of CD 1174. I think we may have discussed this. I find it nonsense that because Snyder was in New York, "it was not possible" for him to review his testimony.

I think it best that but one of us deal with Barry, and nothing else is really fair to him. So, when you ask him about checking the testimony, ask him, please, to read Snyder's very carefully and be absolutely certain that the "few pencilled corrections" are only "for grammatical and factual accuracy". Especially "factual accuracy". Some of the alleged "errors" might be interesting. Ask him to get a copy of any and all corrections of which he has the slightest question.
