In view of the alleged mental condition of [redacted] mother of [redacted] and in view of the past performance of the informant, Miami should have no further contact with the former informant in regard to the information that [redacted] and five other individuals were involved in the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr.

In view of the fact that in interview with [redacted] she denies any knowledge of this alleged participation in the assassination and refuses to discuss it, receiving offices should conduct no further investigation in this aspect.

If any further information comes to your attention regarding this, you should notify the Bureau of same, submit your recommendations and take no further action.
