## MORE INVOLVED IN POISON PLOT

Philadelphia Officials Issue Warrants

PHILADELPHIA (AP)—Warrants were issued Friday for three more Philadelphia men, raising to seven the number accused of plotting to blow up public buildings, assassinate Philadelphia's mayor and other city leaders and poison hundreds of police should they be on riot duty.

Three of four men previously charged in the alleged murder scheme were held in \$25,000 bail each for court action.

Investigators have linked the plots to bomb and poison to the Revolutionary Action Movement (RAM), a Negro extremist group which allegedly has Red China sympathies.

Named in the latest warrants were Karl Clowers, and two brothers, George and Lonnie Anderson. They are charged with solicitation for murder and solicitation to commit riotous destruction of property.

Held in the alleged police poison plot were Anthony B. On-teiro, a former Philadelphian who was living in Chicago, 22; William Lyles, 26, and Reginald Grantham, 21, all of Philadelphia. A fourth man, identified only as John Doe, is still sought.
