Philadelphia Charges

PHILADELPHIA — The arrest of a Philadelphia Bulletin reporter on wiretapping charges led District Attorney Arlen Specter to accuse Pennsylvania Crime Commission investigators of baiting Philadelphia policemen.

Specter said that Greg Walter, arrested last week for allegedly taping telephone conversations without notifying participants, was helping commission investigators bribe a policeman.

The Philadelphia police department has been the target of investigations by both Specter's office and the crime commission. Several policemen have been indicted on charges ranging from accepting bribes to

aiding narcotics
