Attached hereto are copies of the lab notes for the emission spectrography analysis performed by the FBI upon certain bullet fragments associated with the assassination of President Kennedy. You stated to me in your letter of June 4, 1975 that a copy of the ES results furnished to you by the FBI showed no presence for silver, tin and bismuth in the samples designated Q-2, Q-4, Q-5, Q-9 and Q-14.
