Dear Emory,

Thanks for the duplicate xeroxes of the last DV spectro material. I'll give Jim Lesar a set Monday, when I expect to see him.

There was no duplication of the last three pages, but no matter. I'm glad to get the one because the masking leaves no doubt that these were made from the set from which mine were. The masking is the proof.

On the 23rd Jim and I conferred with FBI FOIA people on C.A.75-1996. This relates to King materials. They called Kilty in when I noted the absence of what should have been provided. He stonewalled on everything, even the price of dupes of the spectro plates. (There were some on King.) In the course of this he lied, so it might be of use to Jim, if it presents no problems to you, to have a separate letter and record of what you paid for the copies of the plates. Kilty told Jim and me \$50 each.

Perhaps it is technically true that Nichols got what he did under FOIA. The actuality is that he got what he did because I shook it loose, as you've seen in Post Mortem.

If Guinn doesn't know that this data is woefully incomplete he knows nothing.

This case is now set for oral arguments, meaning okayed for it. The date has not been set. I believe our complaint is all inclusive, so spectro comparison samples are included. However, I think if you have the time an explanation of this for Jim in such form that he can use it in court might be helpful.

There is little likelihood of anything coming from Vhurch now. Perhaps after the reports are out there may be reason to rethink this but I don't expect it.

I seem to be making out okay, thanks.

For my files, whatever you saw that made you see the light concerning the CIA and Messrs. Fensterwald and Saltzman I'd like to have, again if it isn't a lot of trouble. These people represent the major problem for the recent past and in the past year with the Congress. It also may at some point be possible to undo some of this harm, so knowing any specifics might then be useful.
