One of the things I've intended doing in "ew Orleans and never gotten around to is interviewing Preston Devis and Eva Springer, if they are still around. Both, really, confirmed Andrews' story, aspecially Davis. Neither was questioned for information by the FBI. Both, undoubtedly, have some. If your office has ever interviewed either, I am unaware of it.

There should be time when I am there for this, If you agreem please ask Louis to have them located to save time. Thatkis, their home addresses and phones, possibly their places of employment.

I think it probable the defense has slready questioned both, may have statements from them.

Nomatheless, more, especially if this is true, I think they should be spoken to.

If you have spoken to them, I'd appreciate copies of the statements so I can read them in advence, compare them with what I have.

With Davis, and with his knowing that Andrews spoke the truth about Cawald having been in the office, if he is the usual run of investigator, is it not reasonable to assume this might have excited his interest and he might have developed information on his own afterward? I am willing to assume he knew more than the FBI report (CD75:195) shows.
