

British May Swap Soviet Spy Team

LONDON (AP)—The American spy team of Morris and Lola Cohen may be returned to the Soviet Union under a deal being negotiated by Russian and British authorities.

The British Foreign Office announced yesterday negotiations were being conducted for the release of Gerald Brooke, a British citizen imprisoned in the Soviet Union in 1965 on a charge of distributing anti-Communist leaflets.

The Russians have said repeatedly Brooke would not be released unless the British agreed to release Mr. and Mrs. Cohen, who received 20-year prison terms here in 1961 for passing North Atlantic Treaty Organization secrets to the Soviet Union.
