Deposition of RUTH JEANETTE STANDRIDGE, 6 H 115 ff. - March 21, 1964.

Miss Standridge is the nurse who helped undress Governor Connally. She saw no bullet and heard none fall. She said the President was also unclothed completely, as is the standard practice. She gave the Fovernor's clothing to Cliff Carter of his staff after first speaking to the hospital administrator (P.118). There apparently was no police, Secret Service or FBI interest. There then follows several sentendes which do not logically follow. They relate to something being found later in a close in the office of Congressman Gonzalez of Texas in Washington. What was found is not indicated.
