REGIONAL FOREIGN POLICY CONFERENCE LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, MAY 5, 1966

The Department of State will hold a Regional Foreign Policy Conference in Little Rock, Arkansas on Thursday, May 5, 1966, sponsored by Little Rock University. About thirty community organizations are cooperating in the conference.

Invitations will be extended to business and community leaders, representatives of national non-governmental organizations and members of the press, radio, and television from Arkansas, Oklahoma, southern Missouri, and western Tennessee.

The purpose of the meeting is to bring together citizen leaders and media representatives with government officials responsible for formulating and carrying out foreign policy.

Government officials now scheduled to participate in the conference include George W. Ball, Under Secretary of State; Richard Reuter, Special Assistant to the Secretary of State (Food for Peace Program); J. Robert Schaetzel, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for European Affairs; David H. Popper, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for International Organization Affairs; Mrs. Charlotte Moton Hubbard, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for Public Affairs; and Robert H. Miller, Director, Viet-Nam Working Group, Bureau of Far Eastern Affairs.
