SUBJECT: MURKIN

On 4/26/68, MARIE LEE, 2001 Claire Avenue, Gretna, Louisiana, telephonically contacted the writer and advised that she wished to point out to the FBI that she did not say most of the things that appeared in the newspaper article on April 25 and 26, 1968. She stated that she did not know anything about MARIE MARTIN, CHARLES STEIN, and RITA STEIN, being requested to register for GEORGE WALLACE on the California Presidential Primary Ballot, and further stated that she could not recall the exact date that STEIN was in New Orleans, and therefore it would have been impossible for her to furnish these dates to the newspaper. She also stated that she did not characterize GALT as a big spender, because she did not know him.

Mrs. LEE stated that she was making this call to set the record straight concerning her exact knowledge of STEIN's trip, and to advise that the newspaper had distorted, and added to her story.
