2 In the meantime, back upstairs at
3 422 1/2 South Main, Charles Quitman Stevens,
4 who occupied these two rooms adjacent to a
5 bathroom here (indicating), Mr. Stevens,
6 who earlier in the afternoon had observed
7 Mrs. Brewer as she talked to the Defendant
8 with reference to renting the room, Mr.
9 Stevens was working on a radio adjacent to
10 this wall right here (indicating). He
11 heard movements over in the apartment 5-B
12 rented to the Defendant, movements around
13 as if furniture being moved. He also
14 heard footsteps from this area into the
15 bathroom (indicating).

16 During this period of time, Mr. William
17 Anchutz, who lived in this apartment,
18 (indicating), had on several occasions gone
19 and attempted the door to the bathroom and
20 had even questioned Mr. Stevens about who
21 was in the bathroom.

22 At approximately 6:00 P.M., Mr. Stevens
23 heard the shot coming apparently through
24 this wall from the bathroom (indicating).
