A new leap: "Quantum Leap" executive producer Don Bellisario is laying plans to "leap" his time-traveling Sam Beckett character (Scott Bakula) into Elvis Presley next season — and he's also talking about having Sam time/body travel into a member of Marilyn Monroe's entourage during the actress's final days. It's all happening, he said, because of the two-hour season opener — in which Sam leaps into President Kennedy assassin Lee Harvey Oswald. "It's opening the door to a new kind of story for us, where we can involve well-known people. I've figured out a way to get around the problems of changing history. Now that I see it's working, I think we can do all kinds of these stories."

Bellisario, who has been vocal about his distaste for Oliver Stone's "JFK," created the special "Quantum" episode in response to the controversial film. "I thought, 'If Oliver Stone can do his fantasy, I can do mine,' " said the producer, who lived in Dallas and worked closely with Democratic Party figures in the years following the assassination. "And I read everything that came out about it." He said he also met — and had a heated argument with — Oswald during their Marine Corps days. Oswald's pro-Soviet harangue always will stay in his mind, he said, along with "his smirk

and know-it-all attitude."
