'Inside' information on CIA-Lee Oswald link

Bill O'Reilly says his story today on *Inside Edition* links Kennedy assassin Lee Harvey Oswald to the CIA — but the mainstream press is ignoring him.

"They won't even get on the phone to hear what I have," says O'Reilly, who has worked the Kennedy assassination

story for the past 12 years "in dribs and drabs."

On today's show (check local listings) O'Reilly discloses sealed reports from the House Assassination Committee, showing that a high-ranking member of the CIA met with Oswald two months before the Nov. 22, 1963, assassination

and that another CIA employee had contact with Oswald right up to the assassination. (The CIA has denied any link to Oswald).

O'Reilly says his sources fear that their reports will never see the light of day—even if the government unseals all files on the assassination. Giving them to Edition ensures that "they get to the public unfiltered," O'Reilly says.
