



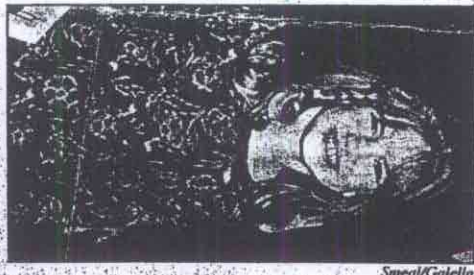
The muscular Mrs. McLish gets glamorous with husband, Ron

Q Now that the Warren Commission's secret archives may be made public, wouldn't you say that Oliver Stone, the director of "JFK," has been more than vindicated?—S. Bannon, St. Louis, Mo.

A On the contrary, many knowledgeable people are betting that when those archives are thrown open—and no decision has been made to do so—they will discredit Stone's cockamamie theory that John F. Kennedy was the victim of a cabal consisting of Cuba, the Mafia, the CIA, the Joint Chiefs of Staff and Lyndon Johnson. Author William Manchester, who spent three years investigating JFK's assassination, writes: "Those who desperately want to believe the President was the victim of a conspiracy have my sympathy. I share their yearning. It would invest his death with meaning... Unfortunately, there is no evidence whatever that there was one."

He was indicted with former Filipino First Lady Imelda Marcos on racketeering and fraud charges, later arrested and thrown into a Swiss prison, where the diminutive Saudi businessman had to clean his own toilet. He also was forced to sell his yacht, and creditors impounded his jet. Today, Khashoggi lives most of the time in Spain, is still fighting his legal battles and, according to court records, he's down to his last \$54 million.
