

"I had no idea in 1963 that this would be as important as it became. (it referring to the reaction to the assassination)....
I had no concept of the depths to which it would change our society. Those questions have become clearer to me with time and hindsight, and that's one of the things I'm trying to illuminate in the movie: Why he was killed, and what happened after he was killed. I think the country definitely took a turn, a fork in the road, with Vietnam; I've said this publicly before."
