

JFK nixed by Dick in flick

Conspiracy theorists rejoice!

For those of you who just can't accept that President John Kennedy was assassinated by Lee Harvey Oswald, film director Oliver Stone has come up with a new suspect — Richard Nixon.

A draft of the script to Stone's next movie, "Nixon," has Nixon conjuring a plan to assassinate Cuban strongman Fidel Castro called "Track 2." Among other things, then-Vice President Nixon organizes CIA agents, Cuban refugees, mobsters and right-wing businessmen into a secret hit squad.

The Castro hit never happens. But three years later, Kennedy was slain in Dallas by — you guessed it — members of "Track 2." And FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover knew all about it.

At least that's the way the script obtained by Time magazine reads.

Stone dispenses with historical accuracy right from the start of the movie that begins with a prologue saying "some scenes between protagonists have been imagined."

It has Nixon at the height of the Watergate scandal personally erasing White House tapes that refer to "Track 2."

The script goes on to show chief of staff Alexander Haig nudging Nixon to resign by telling the President that somebody has a duplicate of the tell-tale tape.
