Filmmaker Oliver Stone urged a group of graduating seniors at the University of California at Berkeley to be wary of "official history." Stone's controversial 1991 film, "JFK," challenged the Warren Commission's finding that the assassination of President John F. Kennedy was carried out by a lone assassin. "Every night you see Dan Rather and his clones, trying to sell their version of events, repeated through channels A, B, C, D, E," Stone said.
