

White Supremacist to Testify Before Panel on King Slaying

ATLANTA (AP) — J.B. Stoner, who calls himself a white supremacist, says he will appear voluntarily before the House assassinations committee to testify about the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

A source in Washington said Saturday the committee has subpoenaed Stoner and several of his associates in connection with Stoner's assertion that an FBI informant offered him \$25,000 to have King assassinated and \$2,000 to blow up a church in Birmingham, Ala.
