Stout Sr., 79, Dies; Burial Tomorrow

Arthur Wendel Stout Sr., retired shipbuilding executive and Episcopal lay leader, died yesterday after a brief illness. He was 79.

Funeral services will be held at 4 p. m. tomorrow at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, followed by interment in Metairie Cemetery Mausoleum. The Rev. Ralph H. Kimball, rector of St. Andrew's, will be celebrant.

A native of Morrilton, Ark., Mr. Stout served in various executives offices of Todd Shipyards Corp. in New Orleans, Mobile, Houston and New York for over 40 years.

He was an active member of St. Andrew's, and in numerous civic and social affairs. He lived here from 1923 until 1939 and returned to the city in 1965.

He is survived by his wife, the former Willa Elizabeth Du Fresne; two sons, Arthur W. Stout Jr. and Thomas Armstead Stout; a daughter, Mrs. Charles Lindley Zwiener; 9 grandchildren.
